

Financial Empowerment Network Link Policy

As a public service, the Financial Empowerment Network (FEN) may provide links to other organizations that provide information and resources of benefit to Washington residents and organizations.

External links do not constitute an endorsement by FEN of the opinions, products or services presented on the external site, or of any sites linked to it.

External links are intended to support FEN's mission. They are not intended to support private or commercial organizations or businesses.

Types of Websites We Link To

The most common websites we link to are .org, .gov, .edu sites that provide information related to FEN's mission.

Sites we typically link to are:

- Organizations that specifically offer resources, information, or services to individuals and communities who are low-income, un- or under-banked, BIPOC, or otherwise marginalized
- Nonprofit organizations or those that provide a service at low-to-no cost or with an affordable sliding scale option
- Federal, state and local government agencies
- Organizations engaged in a partnership with FEN

Types of Websites We Do Not Link To

- Websites which are primarily commercial in nature (i.e., advertising, promoting or recommending a particular product or business, charging a usage fee, soliciting user information, etc.)
- Websites which exhibit hate, bias, or discrimination or promote one political party over another
- Websites which charge a user-fee for access
- Websites that are deemed to be misleading, contain unsubstantiated claims or are determined to be in conflict with FEN's mission
